How to run a stag, bachelorette, jack & jill, baby shower, or fundraiser that actually works for your guest of honor.

The one thing nobody tells first-time organizers.

If you remember only one thing from this guide, make it this.

The ticket price is not the fundraiser. Tickets cover food and the venue. The real money for your guest of honor comes from raffles, baskets, 50/50s, and side games.

Most first-time event organizers assume pricing tickets low will sell more and raise more money. In practice, the opposite happens. The venue cost stays the same no matter what you charge — so every dollar above break-even goes **directly** to your guest of honor. And the crowd a \$50 ticket attracts tends to spend 2–3× more on raffles than a \$35 ticket crowd. At 50 guests, your ticket price has to work harder — with only half the revenue pool, the same venue cost eats a much bigger share.

The real math: 50 guests, same venue, same food.

At \$35 a ticket

What most first-time organizers default to.

Ticket revenue	\$1,750
Venue + food cost	-\$1,750
Margin from tickets	\$0
Raffles + side games	\$1,400

Total to guest of honor	\$1,400
-------------------------	----------------

At \$50 a ticket

Same guests. Same food. Different outcome.

Ticket revenue	\$2,500
Venue + food cost	-\$1,750
Margin from tickets	\$750
Raffles + side games	\$1,900

Total to guest of honor	\$2,650
-------------------------	----------------

Same venue. Same food. \$1,250 more for your guest of honor. That \$15 ticket difference doesn't vanish into overhead — it lands directly in their end-of-night envelope.

What actually raises money at your event.

These are the numbers we see at Manor Lanes events, with crowds of 40–60 guests.

Basket / Chinese auction

10–20 themed baskets · guests buy tickets and drop in cups

\$500 – \$1,500

50/50 raffle

Multiple pulls through the night build excitement

\$200 – \$500

Gun raffle

WNY tradition — pre-sell tickets before the event

\$400 – \$1,500

Bottle pull

Guests pay \$20 to pull a mystery bottle from the rack

\$150 – \$300

Queen of Hearts / Joker Poker

Game-board specialty raffles run throughout the event

\$150 – \$600

Straw / Joker pull

\$5 a pick, winner takes the pot

\$75 – \$250

A well-run 50-guest event nets the guest of honor \$2,000–\$4,000. A poorly-planned one nets under \$1,000 because the organizer priced tickets cheap and didn't set up enough side games.

The insight: treat tickets as admission to the money-making machine, not the machine itself. Price tickets to cover your hard costs with a small cushion. Design the event so guests have five different ways to contribute to the guest of honor.

Capabilities no other venue offers.

You could rent a hall. This is what you get when you pick us.

✓ Digital 50/50 System

Run your 50/50 raffle entirely digitally. Guests scan a QR code to buy entries, the pot total updates live on the AV matrix, and the winner is drawn on screen. No paper mess, no lost tickets.

✓ Shared Google Sheet Planning

We share a live planning sheet. Your baskets, prizes, sponsor logos, and run-of-show — all synced before game day.

✓ Building-Wide AV Matrix

Run your videos, photos, or sponsor logos on every screen in the building — not just one TV in the corner.

✓ Custom BES-X Graphics

Name on the lanes. Custom logos. Personalized score screens. Given 2+ weeks lead time, we create one-off visuals for your event.

✓ Lane Tournament Scoring

Strike pots, high-game prizes, team brackets. Live leaderboards on the screens. Another way to generate excitement (and side revenue).

✓ Cornhole Tournament App

Bracket management, live scoring, winner announcements — on our outdoor sand courts. Nobody else in WNY offers this.

✓ Outdoor Patios + Stadium Sound

Two patios, sand courts with stadium-grade LED lighting for volleyball and cornhole, and a sound system that makes it feel like you're in an outdoor arena. Move the party outside for the last stretch.

✓ Moonlight Bowling

Blacklights, music, full bowling-alley energy. Optional add-on to cap off an event.

Why this matters for your event: a digital 50/50 with QR buy-in typically doubles per-guest participation vs. passing around a paper bucket. Personalized AV creates a "this was made for me" moment your guest of honor won't forget. Tournament side-games open new revenue streams you can't run in a hall.

Ticket math & timeline.

What to charge for tickets, and when to do what.

The math below assumes The 10th Frame package at \$34.95/guest × 50 guests ≈ \$1,750 total — the typical fit for adult fundraising events.

What to charge per ticket.

TICKET PRICE	WHAT IT FUNDS	NET TO GUEST OF HONOR (50 GUESTS)*
\$30	Loses money on tickets alone	\$800 – \$1,100
\$40	Small margin + decent raffle	\$1,500 – \$1,900
\$50	Sweet spot — recommended	\$2,400 – \$2,900
\$60	Premium event, higher per-head raffle spend	\$3,200 – \$3,800

*Assumes The 10th Frame package. Raffle take varies based on number of games offered and prize quality. For groups larger than 50, ticket prices can drop proportionally while maintaining net-to-guest-of-honor.

Planning timeline.

8 WEEKS OUT	Pick your date, pay deposit. Sign your event agreement. We open your shared planning sheet and add you to our scheduling calendar.
6 WEEKS OUT	Start ticket sales + basket outreach. Start collecting basket donations. We give you our sponsor outreach template if you want it.
4 WEEKS OUT	Finalize menu + AV assets. Send us photos, videos, logos, custom graphics requests. We start building your personalized visuals.
2 WEEKS OUT	Final headcount + raffle setup. We finalize your digital raffle system, set up your QR codes, and walk through the run-of-show.
EVENT DAY	Arrive 90 minutes early. Set up baskets, brief your team, test the AV. We handle everything else.
